
# 180 Days to Designer

In addition to your Training Show or your Renewal Show, you'll need to do 36 more Home Shows and sponsor seven new Jewelers in 180 days. You can do it!

Goal One: Quick Start and Rookie Team



Goal Two: Home Show Club and Builder



Goal Three: Designer



## Quick Start

For new Jewelers and for current Jewelers on their annual anniversary. Hold six Home Shows in the first 45 days after your Training Show (or after your Renewal Show) and earn a \$200 retail jewelry certificate. Hold nine shows in the same time period and earn an additional \$100 retail jewelry certificate.

#### Joan's Rookie Team

For new Jewelers. Hold a total of 12 Home Shows and sponsor two new Jewelers within six months of your Training Show and you will be rewarded with a \$300 retail certificate and special team recognition.

## Home Show Club

You'll become a member of this club when you've held 25 Home Shows in 120 consecutive days. That's four months, five to six shows a month - just do one show a week...and then one more.

## Builder

You'll achieve the Builder leadership level once you have held a total of 24 Home Shows and have sponsored a total of four new Jewelers in a 12-month accounting period. Plus, you will be rewarded with a \$300 retail jewelry certificate!

#### Designer

Once you achieve Builder, all you have to do is hold 12 more Home Shows and sponsor three more new Jewelers in a 12-month accounting period to achieve Designer. Then you'll be rewarded with a \$500 retail jewelry certificate and be eligible to earn Designer leadership trips!
